

Steel Swimming Pool - Base Requirements

GENERAL

Preparing the correct base for your particular pool is critical from a safety aspect. Always consult your specific full pool assembly manual.

ACTION



Ideally select an area which is flat, away from trees and power lines. If levelling a site always remove material from the slope. DO NOT add material to level the ground.

Remove grass, plants and roots as these can cause liner damage.

DO NOT construct directly onto grass or patio/concrete area.

DO NOT construct onto decking or other constructed platform.

SAND BASE

Typically round pool.

Remove surface to a depth recommended for specific pool model. We would recommend the installation of a weed suppression membrane at this point (optional)



Ideally select an area which is flat, away from trees and power lines. If levelling a site always remove material from the slope. DO NOT add material to level the ground.

The base should be a minimum 1 %" thick when compacted. **CAUTION** pool will be in danger of collapse if the sand is not compacted correctly.

We would recommend that a felt underlay is laid on the compacted sand to now construct the pool on.

CONCRETE BASE

Typically oval pool.



Consult the specific recommendations in your main pool model manual.

You may need to have a specific concrete thickness and steel work. If in doubt take professional advice from your builder.



Always allow sufficient time for the concrete to cure before commencing with pool build.
